

# Fort Wainwright USARTRAK

## What is USARTRAK?

It is the U.S. Army Recreation Tracking System (USARTRAK). USARTRAK has been established to facilitate public access to Fort Wainwright training lands, and allows recreational users to check in by phone, or online at [www.usartrak.com](http://www.usartrak.com).  
**(If they have a Recreation Access Permit.)**

As always, recreational activities are permitted in Fort Wainwright Training Areas, (providing they do not conflict with the military mission or training activities.)

The USARTRAK system is designed to keep you informed of training area closures.

**In the interest of safety, you must stay within the boundaries of the training areas open to recreation.**

### How To Gain Recreational Access to Fort Wainwright Training Lands

#### 1. Obtain a Recreation Access Permit (RAP).


This is issued at the front gate visitor's centers at Fort Wainwright and Fort Greely, Natural Resource Office on each post, or online.

**2. Check in by calling the USARTRAK automated phone system.** This must be done before entering the training lands and you will need your RAP number to access the system. The system provides daily training closures.

### USARTRAK CHECK IN SYSTEM

Your recreation permit number is all you need to access this phone system. If dialing from a military phone (DSN) you must use a 907 prefix.

When you call the USARTRAK phone line a series of prompts will allow you to: select a recreation area, choose your activity, and learn about training area closures.

Multiple permit numbers can be entered at the beginning for groups, and there is no checkout requirement.





**Following is a sample menu of the USARTRAK phone system:**

- A. Welcome message
- B. USARTRAK offers the following options:
  1. Quit
  2. To hear Regional Closures for:
    - a. Fort Wainwright Main Post
    - b. Tanana Flats Training Area
    - c. Yukon Training Area
    - d. Donnelly East of the Delta River
    - e. Donnelly West of the Delta River
    - f. Gerstle River Training Area
    - g. Black Rapids and Whistler Creek Training Areas
  3. To hear closures for a specific training area enter 3 digit training area number you plan to visit. For Gerstle River TA enter 600.
  4. To check into a training area
    - a. Enter your permit number / confirm your permit number
    - b. Enter additional permit numbers if you are traveling in a group
    - c. Choose an activity
      - i. Big Game Hunting
      - ii. Small Game Hunting
      - iii. Fishing
      - iv. ORV
      - v. Trapping
      - vi. Firewood/Christmas Tree Cutting
      - vii. Other (all other activities not listed or related to the above such as birding, berry picking, hiking, mushing, etc)
    - d. Enter the number of days you plan to visit (You must choose between 1-25)
    - e. Enter the 3 digit training area number you plan to visit
    - f. You have completed the automated check in
