SUBJECT: Environmental Policy Statement (Garrison Policy #37)

1. The US Army Garrison Fort Wainwright (USAG FWA) is firmly committed to a policy of environmental stewardship for all lands under its control. The USAG FWA is committed to the development and implementation of an Environmental Management System (EMS) in accordance with the requirements of Executive Order 13423, "Strengthening Federal Environmental, Energy, and Transportation Management"; International Organization for Standardization (ISO) 14001 standard for an EMS; and Army Regulation (AR) 200-1.
2. The USAG FWA's policy of environmental stewardship is a commitment to the following:
 - a. Maintaining compliance with applicable legal requirements.
 - b. Prevention of pollution through identifying, implementing, and promoting pollution prevention strategies.
 - c. Continual improvement through setting and reviewing environmental goals, objectives and targets.
3. This environmental policy will be reviewed annually by the Environmental Quality Control Committee (EQCC) to ensure that USAG FWA's commitments are consistent with the garrison's operations and sustainability goals.
4. This policy supersedes Garrison Policy #31, SAB, dated 10 Apr 09.
