

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Turn-in and Storage of 20' MILVANS and Unit Shipping Containers (Garrison Policy #48)

1. References: None applicable.
2. Applicability: This policy applies to all military units, tenant units and separate agencies stationed on Fort Wainwright.
3. Purpose: To establish guidelines to ensure the proper use and storage of shipping containers on Fort Wainwright.
4. Policy: 20 foot MILVAN containers will be turned into the Directorate of Logistics (DOL) Deployment Support Branch container yard within 60 days of completion of any training/exercise deployment rotation or any real world deployment. All units requiring use of 20 foot containers for storage must have a letter of approval from USARAK G-4, listing justification and container USAU number.
5. All TRICONS, ISU 90, QUADCON and 20 foot MILVAN containers will be stored in unit motor pool or supply yards. Storage location must not interfere with emergency response vehicles. Containers must not be stacked unless specifically designed to do so and in safe working condition to prevent injury to personnel. Storage of munitions or radiation equipment within containers is not authorized.
6. Units that violate this policy are subject for pick-up of containers within three (3) days after DOL Container Manager posts a container pick-up letter on the container and notifies unit/agency of the violation. The container will be bolt sealed and placed in the DOL Container Yard. Units will be accountable for all equipment and supplies stored in the container and responsible to coordinate any movement of equipment or supplies from the container or movement of container from DOL Container Yard to unit approved designated area.
7. After seven (7) days of container detention, the DOL Container Manager will notify the responsible unit commander or agency director of this violation. The violation will then be forwarded to the Garrison Commander's office for action.
