

QUESTION: My father, who loves to walk, is visiting our home on post. Can he obtain a pass to return to post after walking off post?

ANSWER: Below is a copy from the Access Control Policy. The process has been simplified. If the person wants she can stop by my office and we can take care of it. She just needs to call first to make sure one of use is here.

"Service Member Sponsored Guests: Fort Wainwright military service members living in family housing/quarters on post may sponsor visiting relatives, family friends or child-care providers access to the installation. To qualify, the guest(s) must be temporarily residing in the sponsor's family housing/quarters or require frequent access to the quarters. The sponsor must complete the request and submit it to the installation Director of Emergency Services. If and when it is approved, the guest – with their privately owned, rented, or leased vehicle – and the sponsor may proceed to the visitors' center to be issued the appropriate vehicle pass/permit. A driver's pass will be issued when the guest is driving the sponsor's DOD registered vehicle. The vehicle pass/permit will not exceed the expiration date listed on the approved request. Both the DoD Decal and temporary pass must be displayed".
