

QUESTION: When will soldiers and their families see the privatization take affect?

ANSWER: Utilities privatization is already underway with the new owner, Doyon Utilities. The official handover was completed at all three Alaskan posts on August 15th.

The transparency that we all hoped for can be attributed to long hours of hard work by both sides and a large percentage of Doyon Utility employees being previous government utility workers who transitioned to new jobs with Doyon Utilities.

For many people the only changes they will notice are a new fleet of utility vehicles around post and new uniforms and badges on people they've seen for many years.

Contact numbers for trouble calls and emergencies stay the same and the government has a quality assurance staff to ensure the services under Doyon Utilities are of the same or higher quality than what the government provided.
