SUBJECT: Fort Wainwright Installation Action Council (IAC) Meeting Minutes
21 October 2009

1. Sonja Taylor, Customer Service Officer (CSO), called the Fort Wainwright (FWA) Installation Action Council meeting to order at 1300 hours in Building 1555 Garrison Conference Room. COL Jones and the CSO provided opening remarks.

2. Forty one attendees were present: 12 voting members, 25 advisory members, 3 Family Readiness Support Assistants (FRSA) and 1 Senior Family Readiness Group (FRG) Advisor:

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d. FRSA: 16 CAB, 1/25 BTB, 1-5

e. Senior FRG Advisor: 1/25 SBCT

3. Installation Action Council:

a. Agenda was introduced for the meeting.

b. Directorates/agencies provided recommendations on the 7 active/open issues held over from the 22 July 2009 IAC. Council members voted to have them remain active or close based on feedback provided.

4. Issues held open from 22 July 2009 IAC:

a. Accessibility and Security of Trainor Gate – Closed

(1) DES Recommendation: Gate guards are under a contract centrally managed by HQDA. Currently Trainor Gate does not meet the 100 vehicle per hour traffic flow to fund Contract Security Guards (CSG). Using Soldiers for Access Control is not authorized at FPCON A. Future plans are to in-source the Security Guard positions.

(2) IAC Recommendation: The issue was voted closed. COL Jones recommended closing issue until resources become available. Gate will be open by exception for special events. COL Werthman suggested signage to show hours.

b. Sex Offender Employment Post Registration – Active

(1) SJA Recommendation: Including in future contracts a local clause requiring screening of sex offenders and reporting is costly. Local clause will only capture a minority of contractor personnel. There is an Alaska registration system in place for sex offenders.

(2) IAC Recommendation: The issue was voted to remain open. Check contract language for the reporting of sex offenders. DES will check into developing a system to register/check and track sex offenders employed on post. Rights of all parties involved working on post or for companies should be protected.

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d. Spousal Participation in Army Family Programs – Closed

(1) ACS Recommendation: ACS is able to pay for childcare. Outreach Program Coordinator is advertising locally. MOI has been established to form a FRSA Advisory Group. The group will survey families to determine needs and expectations of the community in regard to Army Family programs.

(2) IAC Recommendation: The issue was voted Closed. ACS is providing support of programs. No additional recommendations or suggestion were made.

h. School Children Safety – Closed

(1) DES/SLO Recommendation: Arctic Light Elementary principal states that she has allowed students to enter the school at 0810 instead of 0830. This has alleviated congestion while parents drop off children. The afternoon congestion during pick up times has cleared up as well.

(2) IAC Recommendation: The issue was voted closed. COL Jones recommended closing by exception, may be re-opened pending input to the contrary by DES.

i. Off-Post Soldier and Family Transportation- Closed

(1) ASYMCA Recommendation: ASYMCA is willing to use the Free Ride shuttle bus to transport during non peak hours Soldiers and Family Members to the city bus transfer station on Cushman Street. A schedule would need to be established. ASYMCA will check drop off and pick up schedules that FRA is currently using to help plan stops.

(2) IAC Recommendation: The issue was voted closed.

k. Shuttle Service for Youth – Closed

(1) CYSS Recommendation: CYSS now has buses to transport children and youths. A route is being established. A change in the current position description is in progress to include transportation of passengers which requires random drug testing. Parents will have to pick up passengers at Youth Services they are not able to drive to a passenger's residence.

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(2) IAC Recommendation: The issue was voted closed.

d. Scheduled Bus Route on Post – Open

(1) CSO Recommendation: Need has not been established, will survey Soldiers to determine need and usage.

(2) IAC Recommendation: The issue was voted to remain open. A survey will be conducted by the CSO to determine need and potential use. Results will be reported back at the next IAC.

5. Council members were advised next IAC will meet 11 December 2009 at 1100 in the Garrison Conference Room.

6. COL Jones provided closing remarks and adjourned the meeting at 1410 hours.
