Finding of No Significant Impact for the Infrastructure and Operational Support for the 25th Aviation Regiment Company D Unmanned Aircraft System Environmental Assessment

The Army announces the availability of the Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) for the environmental assessment (EA) that analyzed and evaluated the potential environmental impacts associated with providing the necessary infrastructure and operational support for Company D of the 25th Aviation Regiment to operate the Gray Eagle Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) in Interior Alaska within existing airspace. The FNSI presents the decision made by the US Army Garrison Fort Wainwright, Alaska Garrison Commander to implement the Army's preferred alternative to operate the Gray Eagle UAS from Fort Wainwright, Alaska. The FNSI demonstrates that the Proposed Action would not significantly affect the environment and that an environmental impact statement is not needed.

The EA and draft FNSI were made available for a 30-day public review from August 14–September 12, 2015.
