

# Mitigation

## Past Mitigation for Hangars 2 and 3

Through Section 106 consultation with the Alaska SHPO and other consulting parties, the U.S. Army Garrison Fort Wainwright has entered into several Memoranda of Agreement (MOAs) and Programmatic Agreements and implemented mitigation efforts for past mission-related actions affecting the Ladd Field NHL and Cold War Historic District, including actions specifically affecting Hangars 2 and 3. These mitigation efforts focused on maintenance of resources in the Ladd Field NHL and Cold War Historic District, the compilation of documentation on historic properties (including Hangars 2 and 3), and the development and availability of public outreach materials.

## Proposed Mitigation for Hangars 2 and 3


Significant impacts to cultural resources are expected to occur as a result of the Proposed Action. Through Section 106 consultation with the Alaska SHPO and other consulting parties, an MOA has been drafted that specifies agreed upon mitigation for cultural resources. Mitigation under Alternative 1 and the No Action Alternative are the same, except for the time frame for which they would be completed.

Mitigation measures focus on:

- **Public Outreach**
- **Re-evaluation of the Ladd Field NHL**
- **Stewardship of the Ladd Field NHL**
