THE RENOVATION OF BUILDING 1060 AT FORT WAINWRIGHT, ALASKA**

**FW-MOA-1504a1**

**WHEREAS**, the original *Memorandum of Agreement Between the United States Department of the Army and the Alaska State Historic Preservation Officer Regarding the Renovation of Building 1060 at Fort Wainwright, Alaska* was executed on the 19th day of February, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of the Army (the Army), acting through the United States Army Garrison Fort Wainwright, Alaska (USAG FWA), plans to replace all windows, infill an existing garage door, install an Exterior Insulation Finishing System (EIFS), and make interior changes to Building 1060 (FAI-01257); and

**NOW THEREFORE**, in accordance with Stipulation IV. Amendments of the Agreement, USAG FWA and the State Historic Preservation Officer agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Amend the first **WHEREAS** clause so it reads as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of the Army (the Army), acting through the United States Army Garrison Fort Wainwright, Alaska (USAG FWA), plans to replace all windows on, infill an existing garage door on, install an Exterior Insulation Finishing System (EIFS) on, make interior changes to, and construct a roof-top fan room on Building 1060 (FAI-01257);

2. Amend Stipulation I to add:

A. No changes.


B. Reevaluation of Building 1060. USAG FWA shall perform a reevaluation of the Determination of Eligibility for Building 1060, to be completed within two years of the amendment being signed.
