Meeting called by Joseph Malen, US Army Garrison-Ft. Wainwright

Objective: To continue frequent communication among RPMs to ensure forward progress on Taku.

Jacobs Work Progress: Sarah Belway/Terry Heikkila reports for Jacobs.

Jacobs is completing their punchlist; including the following items (since the last meeting):

- Winterized the site and completed all site work at Taku Gardens for 2007;
- Completed Surface Sampling;
- Moved supersacks, and other waste containers to center of site and winterized area;
- Transferred all soil and water drums from monitoring wells to the DERA building for winter; and
- Planning removal of pesticide soil at DRMO.

CH2M Hill Reports: Jeremy Blei reports for CH2M Hill.

CH2M Hill has been completed the following activities:

- Completed all indoor air/soil gas on 10/03/08, 10 units completed to evaluate attenuation factors. The 10 units were identified based on previous results of highest Freon detections (and high dilution factors) and detection factors of other analytes including TCE, PCE and Benzene. They plan to produce a short summary off results once they are validated;
- Discussed temporal and spatial variables associated with vapor intrusion. ADEC mentioned useful information on vapor instruction in a class that they all attended recently. The hope is that the pilot study will solve the Freon issue and then CH2M Hill can go back and sample all of the units. There was a discussion as to whether old data could be used; and
- Completed October groundwater monitoring event. Twenty-eight wells plus the 5 new wells installed by Jacobs were sampled during this event. The rationale for sampling these wells was identified in the May 2008 Tech Memo.

Discussed UXO clearance of Stryker Facility, which was driven by construction needs. Mr. Malen summarized the findings that included empty drums or drums with soil and a minefield sign. No analytical sampling was conducted but field screening of the drum area was.

As we finish up the field season for 2008, we anticipate at least one more RPM TAKU meeting on 10/28/08 to close out field reports.

EPA Reports: Nothing to report today.

ADEC Reports: Nothing to report today.
