

### How to Gain Recreational Access to Fort Wainwright Training Lands

1. Obtain a Recreation Access Permit. This is issued at the front gate visitor's center at Fort Wainwright and Fort Greely, Natural Resource Office on each post, or online.
2. Check in by calling the USARTRAK automated phone system. This must be done before entering the training lands and you will need your RAP number to access the system. The system provides daily training closures.
