How to Gain Recreational Access to Fort Wainwright Training Lands

- Obtain a Recreation Access Permit (RAP).** This can be obtained online or at one of our three kiosk locations: Fort Wainwright Visitor Center, Fort Greely Visitor Center, and Fort Wainwright Natural Resources office.
 - Check in by calling the USARTRAK automated phone system or online.** This must be done before entering the training lands and you will need your RAP number to access the system.
- This permit is free to all individuals and required by those 16 years of age and older.
