
What is USARTRAK?

It is the U.S. Army Recreation Tracking System. USARTRAK has been established to facilitate public access to Fort Wainwright training lands and allows recreation users to check-in by phone, or online at <https://usartrak.isportsman.net>.

As always, recreation activities are permitted on Fort Wainwright training lands, provided they do not conflict with the military mission or training activities.

The USARTRAK system is designed to keep you informed of training area closures.

**In the interest of safety, you must stay within the boundaries of the training areas open to recreation.**

**USARTRAK PHONE CHECK-IN SYSTEM**

To access the phone system, you will need your recreation permit number and PIN. If dialing from a military phone (DSN), you must use a 907 area code.

When you call the USARTRAK phone line, a series of prompts will allow you to check-in or listen to training area closures. You will then need to select a recreation area, enter your length of stay, and choose your activity.

To check-in online, you will need your recreation permit number and PIN.

**ONLINE OPTIONS:**

- Check-in to training areas for recreation
- Update and renew RAP card; required every two years
- Reprint existing RAP card
- Purchase Wood Cutting Permits with a credit card
- Complete Bear Baiting and Trapping Harvest Reports
- View and print Fort Wainwright Recreation Maps


**HOW TO GAIN RECREATION ACCESS TO FORT WAINWRIGHT TRAINING LANDS:**

- 1. Obtain a Recreation Access Permit (RAP).** This can be obtained online or at one of our three kiosk locations: Fort Wainwright Visitors Center, Fort Greely Visitors Center, and Fort Wainwright Natural Resources Office.
- 2. Check-in online or by calling the USARTRAK automated phone system.** This must be done before entering the training lands, and you will need your RAP number to access the system.

This permit is free to all individuals and is required by those 16 years of age and older.





## USARTRAK PHONE SYSTEM OPTIONS

- Check-in:
  - Enter your permit number and press #
  - Enter your PIN
  - Would you like to add additional permit numbers, if traveling in a group?
  - Enter the number of days you plan to stay (You must choose from 1- 14)
  - Choose an activity from your list of choice
  - Enter your training area(s) 3 digit number
- Listen for a list of closed areas.
