What is USARTRAK?

It is the U.S. Army Recreation Tracking System (USARTRAK). USARTRAK has been established to facilitate public access to Fort Wainwright training lands, and allows recreational users to check in by phone, or online at <http://usartrak.isportsman.net>

As always, recreational activities are permitted in Fort Wainwright Training Areas, (providing they do not conflict with the military mission or training activities.)

The USARTRAK system is designed to keep you informed of training area closures.

In the interest of safety, you must stay within the boundaries of the training areas open to recreation.

How To Gain Recreational Access to Fort Wainwright Training Lands

1. Obtain a Recreation Access Permit (RAP).
This can be obtained online or at one of our three kiosk locations: the Fort Wainwright Visitors Center, Fort Greely Visitors Center, and Fort Wainwright Natural Resource office.

2. Check in by calling the USARTRAK automated phone system or online. This must be done before entering the training lands and you will need your RAP number to access the system.


This permit is free to all individuals and required by those 16 years of age and older.

USARTRAK PHONE CHECK-IN SYSTEM

Your recreation permit number is all you need to access the phone system. If dialing from a military phone (DSN) you must use a 907 prefix.

When you call the USARTRAK phone line a series of prompts will allow you to listen to training area closures, select a recreation area, and choose your activity.


To check-in online, you will need your permit number and pin number.

ONLINE OPTIONS

- Check into training areas for recreating
- Update and renew RAP cards; required every 2 years
- Reprint existing RAP cards
- Purchase Wood Cutting Permits on-line with a credit card
- Complete Bear Baiting and Trapping Harvest Reports
- View/print Fort Wainwright Recreation Maps

- ### USARTRAK PHONE SYSTEM OPTIONS
1. Check-In
 - A. Enter your permit number and press #
 - B. Enter the first 2 letters of your last name
 - C. Would you like to add additional permit numbers if traveling in a group?
 - D. Enter the number of days you plan to stay (you must choose from 1-14)
 - E. Choose an activity from your list of choices
 - F. Enter your training areas 3 digit ID
 2. Listen for a List of Closed Areas


