Downtown Snapshot Tour (1.5 hours): \$45

Tour highlights a few important sites on the riverfront. This tour provides details about early Fairbanks history while visiting a variety of buildings, landmarks and monuments.

Chena Riverfront Tour (2.5 hours): \$70

This tour highlights some history from Fairbanks' downtown riverfront and then travels along the Chena River to Pioneer Park. Once there, riders will have a chance to view some of the town's original log structures, a genuine riverboat, the Harding Car as well as an opportunity to shop for Alaskan merchandise if time allows.

Segway Experience Ride: \$40 per hour

Enjoy just Segway riding. This is a non-structured, lengthy ride in the Fairbanks area, designed for riders who would prefer more gliding and less talking. Your guide will follow the pace the group sets to explore the abilities and limits of the Segway X2 Personal Transporter.

Canyon Run

A 2-hour (11 mile) Alaska whitewater rafting journey with class III and class IV whitewater rapids (minimum age required is 14). The Canyon Run is our most popular Nenana rafting adventure and a true classic. Come prepared to paddle and follow your paddle captain's commands. No experience required. Oar/Paddle Raft: \$69.50 and Oar Youth ages 5 to 13: \$53.50.

Scenic Wilderness (Oar Raft Only)

A 2 Hour (11 mile) Alaska raft adventure for all. This Nenana rafting adventure features mild whitewater with class II and one easy class III rapid (minimum age 5). Float the boundary of Denali National Park in search of wildlife with breathtaking views of The Alaska Range. Adult price: \$69.50 and Youth ages 5 to 13, \$45.60.

Nenana Half-day

This 4 hour (22 mile) Alaska whitewater raft adventure combines the Scenic Wilderness and Canyon Run river trips. Oar/Paddle Raft: \$93.50 and Oar Youth ages 5 to 13: \$77.50.

Kayak Tours \$71.25

These kayak adventures traverse the eastern boundary of Denali National Park, Alaska and explore whitewater on the Nenana River. Kayak Denali park in Alaska for 2 to 3 hours on one of our Otto Lake tours and let Denali Outdoor Center share their knowledge, expertise and the wonders of "mild to WILD" river adventure.

Valdez Glacier Campground

Valdez, Alaska

Located at the base of the Chugach Mountains beneath the famous Valdez Glacier , the campground offers 85 wooded non-electric campsites that can accommodate tents or RVs, 21 powered RV pads (20/30, and 50 amp), RV dump site, shower house, six latrines and camp host information center. All sites include picnic tables and fire rings. We have three large group areas that provide plenty of room for group camping and family events. Daily Tent Sites non-electric: \$10 Military and \$15 Public

Daily RV Sites non-electric: \$15 Military and \$20 Public

RV Pad – 20 and 30 amp hook-up: \$25 Military and \$30 Public
