SUBJECT: Excessive Noise Policy (Garrison Policy #32)

1. References:
 - a. Alaska Statute 11.61.110, Disorderly Conduct.
 - b. Article 134 UCMJ, Disorderly Conduct.
 - c. North Haven Resident Guide.
2. This policy establishes procedures to discourage excessive noise on the installation in order to ensure the quiet and comfort of all individuals.
3. In determining parameters for this policy, "excessive noise" is defined as noises or sounds caused by musical instruments, stereo equipment, power tools, vehicle exhaust, loud conversations, and/or other sources of noise that can be heard beyond 30 feet from a vehicle or residence.
4. Excessive noise is prohibited in the housing and barracks areas from the hours of 2200-0600 (Sunday through Thursday) and 2300-0600 (Friday, Saturday, and holidays). Excessive noise during normal hours is permitted within reason and so long that it does not disturb the comfort of others.
5. Excessive noise emitted from motor vehicles is prohibited at all times on the installation. Examples of excessive noise caused by motor vehicles include loud music and vibrations emitted from stereo systems and excessively loud aftermarket or modified exhaust systems.
6. Violators of this policy are subject to citation by Fort Wainwright Police under Alaska Statute 11.61.110 (Disorderly Conduct) and/or Article 134 UCMJ (Disorderly Conduct). Repeated violations may result in adverse and/or punitive action under the UCMJ, revocation of post driving privileges, eviction from post housing, and/or disbarment from the installation. North Haven housing will be notified by the Fort Wainwright Police of violations that occur in North Haven housing communities.
7. This policy supersedes Garrison Policy #32, subject: Excessive Noise from Privately Owned Vehicles and On Post Housing Policy, dated 24 January 2014.
