SUBJECT: Political Activities (Garrison Policy #42)

1. References:

2. Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to set limits on the political activities of people on the installation. This policy will govern the conduct of anyone on the installation — Soldiers, Family Members, DA Civilian employees, contractors and visitors.

3. General: No one shall conduct political activities or otherwise promote or advance any partisan political cause, candidate, or agenda in a federal government workplace.

4. Policy:


- a. Personal effects of a partisan political nature or supporting a particular partisan candidate or agenda may not be worn or otherwise displayed in the federal government workplace. Personal effects include, but are not limited to, shirts, ties, buttons, coffee mugs, signs, posters, etc.
- b. Government resources may not be used to advance any partisan political cause, candidate or agenda. Such resources include, but are not limited to: computers, email, faxes, etc.
- c. Large signs, posters or banners promoting any partisan political cause, candidate or agenda may not be displayed on the top or side of a personal vehicle or visible to the public at one's residence on a military installation (including homes located in privatized housing). However, ordinary type bumper stickers are allowed on privately owned vehicles.
- d. Partisan political campaign literature may not be distributed on the installation.

5. This policy supersedes Garrison Policy #42, SAB, dated 23 Apr 14.
