MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Minor Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence of Alcohol (Garrison Policy #45)

1. References:

- a. Army Regulation 190-5, Motor Vehicle Traffic Supervision, dated 22 May 2006.
- b. USARPAC Regulation 600-6, Personnel-General, Alcoholic Beverages, dated 13 May 2005.
- c. Alaska Statute 28.35.280, Minor Operating a Vehicle after Consuming Alcohol.

2. Purpose: To provide guidance and specific information regarding incidents of Soldiers under the age of 21 operating a vehicle while under the influence of alcohol during instances when the Soldier is not charged with a violation of Article 111 UCMJ.

3. Policy: Soldiers under the age of 21 with a blood alcohol level equal to or greater than .001 grams of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood that operate a motor vehicle that fails to meet the specifications of Article 111 UCMJ; or that operate a vehicle in connection with another offense will be subject to the following:

- a. The Soldier can expect to be charged by the Fort Wainwright Police with a violation of Article 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice for Failure to Obey an Order or Regulation (Underage Drinking)

- b. The Soldier's on post driving privileges will normally be suspended for 1 year.

4. This policy supersedes Garrison Policy #45, SAB, dated 18 Apr 12.
